CONTENTS: 2 Ski Rack Assemblies

4 Carriage Bolts

4 Wing Nuts

2 Keys

4 *Mounting Clamps*
(sold separately)

IMPORTANT NOTE: This Ski Attachment is designed for assembly on Genuine Subaru Racks only. Due to possible improper fit and the danger that it may detach, installation on other Roof Racks is not recommended.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:

1. Assemble the four Mounting Clamps to the front and rear crossbars.
2. With the locking end of the Ski Rack Assembly facing outboard, place the Ski Rack Assembly on top of the Mounting Clamps. Align the holes in the Ski Rack Assembly with the holes in the Mounting Clamps.
3. Insert the Carriage Bolts through the Ski Rack Assembly and Mounting Clamps. Install one Wing Nut to each Carriage Bolt as shown in Figure 2. **DO NOT TIGHTEN THE WING NUT yet.**
4. Repeat the above procedures for the second Ski Rack Assembly.
5. Make sure Ski Rack Assemblies are in their final position. Securely tighten all four Wing Nuts.
6. Periodically check the Ski Rack Assemblies to insure that all parts are secured.

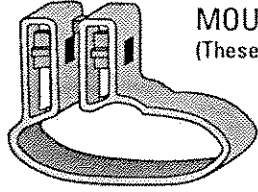
USER INSTRUCTIONS:

The Subaru Ski Rack is designed to carry up to 6 pairs of skis. The exact number of skis carried will vary dependent upon the type of skis, bindings, and/or whether or not ski poles are carried along with the skis. Maximum carrying capacity can be achieved by placing skis bottom to bottom in the Ski Rack Assemblies, dependent upon the type of ski and ski bindings.

CAUTION: • The Ski Rack Assemblies must be locked whenever skis are transported to prevent accidental opening of the Rack Assemblies.
• Care should be taken to prevent contact between skis and the tailgate raised. It is recommended to load skis far enough forward to prevent contact.

Locking is accomplished by turning the key 180 degrees from its unlocked position. With the skis locked into the Ski Rack Assembly, the Rack itself is locked onto the crossbar since the Wing Nuts may not be turned past the ears on the Fixed End Caps.
